This year the school organised pleasure trips for students of classes 10 and 12 to different locations such as Uduppi, Coorg and Mysore. Staff tour to the capital city, Thiruvananthapuram was a well deserved break from the hectic schedule.

The cleaning drive on Gandhi Jayanthi and the the colourful rally on Childrens' Day , the parade on the Republic Day etc have instilled patriotism in our cadre.

The KG section celebrated Colours' Day in July, Fruits Day in August, Flowers Day in Septembe. To acknowledge the efforts of grandparents, we are to conduct a *Grandparents Day* on February 2 with fun filled activities and feast and fanbulous Kids Fest on February 19.

The parades and workshops for 78 SPC members (44 juniors and 34 seniors) under the leadership of Mr. Habeeb Ur Rahman(CPO) and Mrs. Sreeshma(ACPO) have created a highly disciplined set of students .We also hosted a 3 day camp for SPC during Christmas Holidays.

Special programmes:

Teacher Empowerment Programmes:
