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KERALA PIRAVI CELEBRATED WITH ENTHUSIASTIC ACTIVITIES



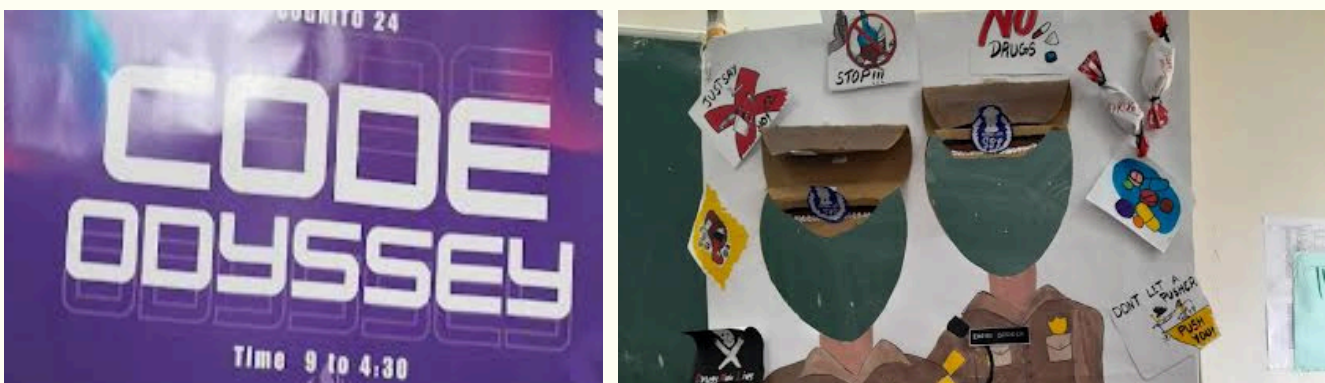
Kerala Piravi Celebrated with Vibrant Cultural Activities

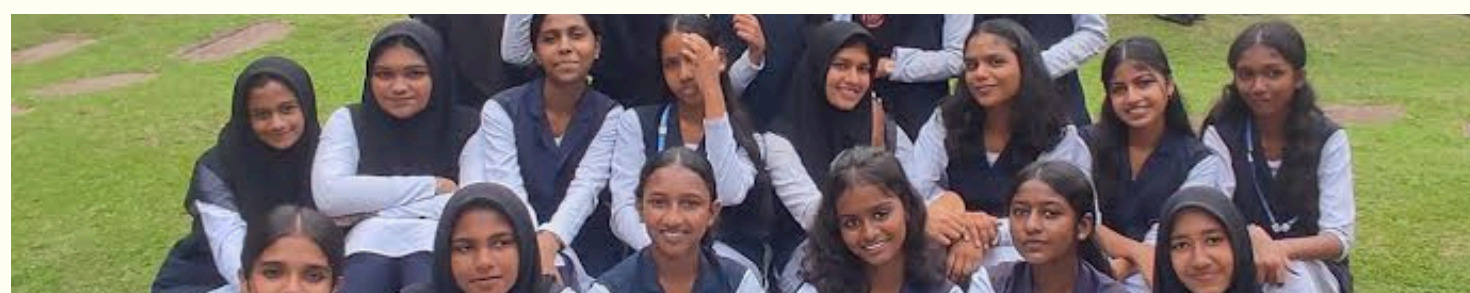
CLASS XII STUDENTS EXPLORE TECH WONDERS AT ROYAL ENGINEERING COLLEGE

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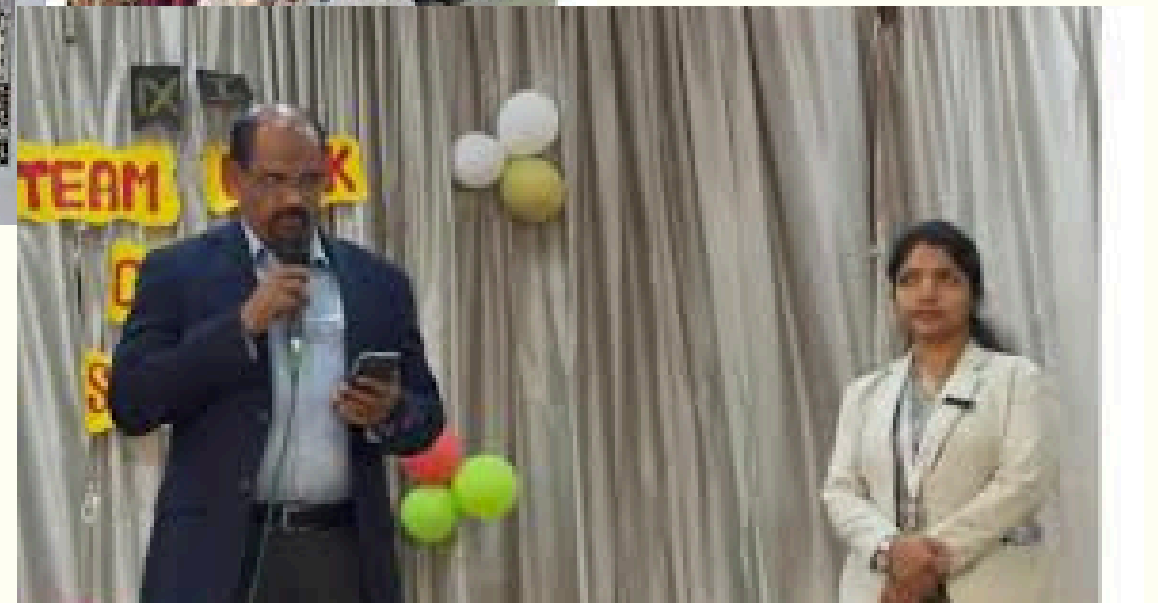
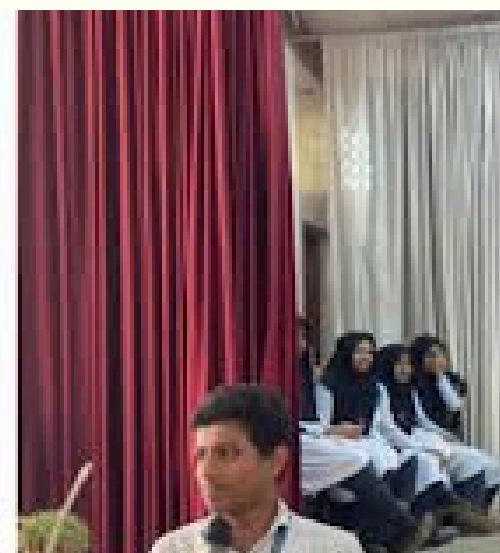
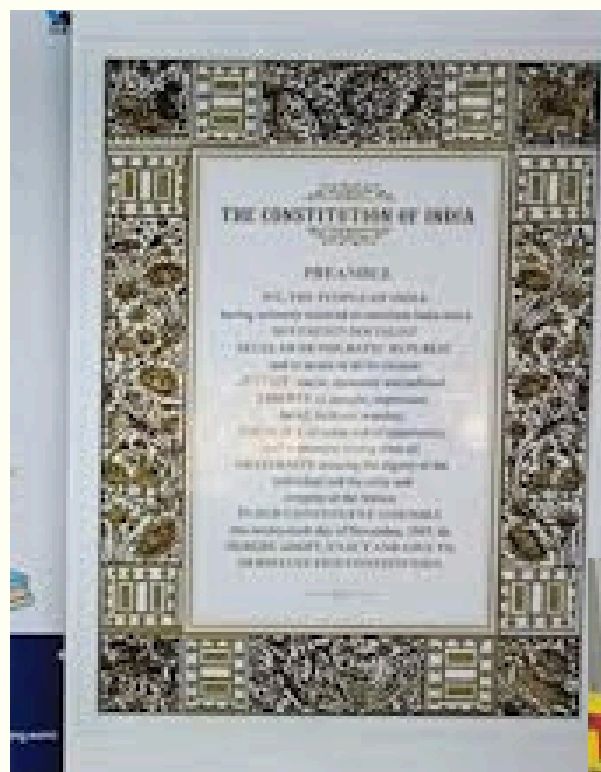
